At **Cheddleton** members took on all aspects of leading the Advent Gift Service, [where gifts are given by members of the congregation and received by staff from the local women's refuge] using prayers from the 16 days. We invited people to write prayers to be added to the prayer tree – which had been decorated with purple and gold material and ribbons. Representatives from the refuge spoke about their work and the difference our support would mean to their clients. They gave out white ribbons, the symbol used by the 'Men working to end men's violence against women' campaign, this campaign uses the day before the 16 days as their promotional day.



A comprehensive working knowledge of computing using Microsoft software is essential.


