For each one of these empowering gifts that you buy we'll send you a beautiful card to give to your mum on Mothering Sunday, or keep in her memory.




By celebrating your mother in this special way you can give women, in the UK and overseas, the faith, education and training they need to transform not only their own lives, but those of their families and communities.

We have been asked by Revd Ray Gaston [who works with the Christian Muslim Forum] if Mothers' Union branches would be willing to work with the forum on developing some Church/ Mosque twinning work in Wolverhampton and Walsall.

They would like the work to be more than just the usual meetings between the faith leaders and want to involve other groups as well.

One idea they have is to link women's groups in the Churches and Mosques.

The launch for the project will take place at All Saints Darleston on Thursday 23rd March between 2pm-4pm. The Bishop of Wolverhampton and Imam Rashid Raja of Wolverhampton Central Mosque will speak briefly and Revd Rachel Parkinson the Chair of Wolverhampton and Shrewsbury Methodist District will hopefully be chairing the proceedings. The idea is that groups, Churches and Mosques will be twinned in partnership for a year.

They envisage Mothers Union being twinned with some of the Women's groups at UKIM Mosques in Walsall and Wolverhampton who have very active women's groups.

The commitment that each pairing makes is to;

- Nominate two reps who will meet 3 times over the year with the partner reps for relationship building
- Arrange visits or meets between wider membership of both groups one meeting in Christian setting the other in Muslim setting and each introduce the other to their work and organisation
- Engage in a project for the common good together.
- Agree to attend a follow up meeting at the end of the year (March 2018) and report back about the experience and consider together next steps.

The aim is to make it enough to be significant but not too much to be a burden.

Val Hanna [Walsall Archdeaconry Leader] and her husband George are attending the meeting, but before the meeting we need to know if we have member support for this venture. As trustees we do not want to commit to something you the members are not able/ willing to continue.

If you would like to attend the meeting Val and George would be more than happy for you to be there with them.
